These women are projected to earn an average total monthly income of Rs 5000-Rs 6000 by rearing 100 chicks. This income will be distributed among these 24 women. Such income generation will upgrade their lifestyle also.

Livelihood impact	<p>Women of Nabasuchana SHG are such beneficiaries of Sohai Swetpur Gram Panchayet. They did not leave a single stone unturned to give a better life to their families. But result was not satisfied. In FY 2020-21 they were allotted a Lemon Orchard called SUFAL BAGICHA/ORCHARD where more than one individual beneficiary can cultivate within a perimeter. This initiative proved to be a real helping hand in boosting the women' income to the range of Rs. 2,80,000/- to Rs. 3,20,000/- This initiative worked as a catalyst in inspiring the other farmers in the nearby villages towards Lemon cultivation.</p> <p>After selection for the scheme, training was given to the beneficiaries. There were total 10 Women in this SHG. They planted 476 no. of lemon seedlings in 60 katha land. There is another profitable side for lemon cultivation that when lemon plant is grown, Brinjal & Cauliflower also can be cultivated under the Lemon plants. The additional income from the Brinjal, Cauliflower particularly during the lockdown period due owing to COVID-19 has been a real boon for the women. Further, the profits earned by the lemon growers under the programme have acted as an eye opener for the other women of the area as well. It is hoped that lemon cultivation under SUFAL Bagicha can prove to be an effective income generation activity in the forthcoming years.</p>

Livelihood impact	<p>Women of Sunami SHG are beneficiaries of Sohai Swetpur Gram Panchayat. They did not leave a single stone unturned to give a better life to their families. But result was not satisfied. In FY 2020-21 they were allotted a Papaya Orchard called SUFAL BAGICHA where more than one individual beneficiary can cultivate within a perimeter. This initiative proved to be a real helping hand in boosting the women' income to the range of Rs. 4,80,000/- to Rs. 6,00,000/- This initiative worked as a catalyst in inspiring the other farmers in the nearby villages towards papaya cultivation.</p> <p>After selection for the scheme, training were given to the beneficiaries. There were total 10 women in this SHG. They planted 1200 no. of papaya seedlings in 60 katha land. There is another profitable side for papaya cultivation that when papaya plant is grown, Pointed Gourd can also be cultivated under the papaya plants. The additional income from the Pointed Gourd particularly, during the lockdown period due to the outbreak of COVID-19 has been a real boon for the women. Further, the profits earned by the papaya growers under the programme have acted as an eye opener for the other women of the area as well. It is hoped that papaya cultivation under SUFAL Bagicha can prove to be an effective income generation activity in the forthcoming years.</p>
